Our first unit is “All About Me,” and so far we have explored emotions, body parts, and have drawn self-portraits. We are gradually expanding this theme to include the school community, the family, the neighborhood, and in anticipation of Rosh Hashanah, the world.

We have worked on routines and expectations in the class, including center tags. The tags are new for this age group, and each center has a number posted showing how many children can be in there at one time. The children are learning to identify the number, check the number in the center, and do pre-arithmetic and cognitive planning for how many children could join, as well as employing self-regulation through their center choices.

As a group we’ve also established class rules, and we are impressed to see the children already incorporating the rules naturally into their daily play. Todah rabah!
